- Will the millennium involve a physical resurrection of Christians to reign on <u>earth</u> during the millennium?
- Will the millennium involve a spiritual resurrection of Christians to reign in <u>heaven</u> during the millennium?



- For God's purpose: God's glory <u>enjoyed</u> by all people. (21:3)






